FREEZE FRAME AT THE MUSEUM

Children love to participate in dramatizations. In the Creative Pursuits Share Fair, 1st and 2nd grade students can dramatize a scene and “freeze” while observers enjoy it. Students will go through the creative thinking and problem solving process as they decide what curriculum connections they want to include.

Problem:

Create a scene (tableau) using a topic from a subject or story you have learned about this year. Each team (4 or 5 students) will create a different scene for observers to enjoy. One student on each team can narrate what is going on in the scene for the audience.

In drama, actors use their bodies and imaginations to show ideas. A tableau is a French word for a still picture representing an idea physically created by actors. The actors are “frozen” in place while people come and look at their scene, like in a museum. Imagine your students involvement in this process and what a creative experience it will be!
