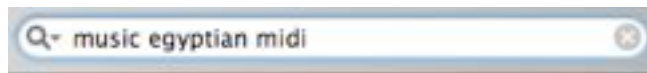


# Music from the Internet to CD

This is a step by step tutorial on moving music from the internet to iTunes to CD. Please follow all copyright guidelines whenever you deal with music or other media. If your usage falls under fair use, please be sure to cite the source of the media.

Step 1: Find the music you want online. As you find sites to download, you need to make sure the music is available in a format that can be downloaded and used on your computer. File formats that you can download include .mp3, .wav, .aif, and midi.

To find music do a search including the words music, the subject you are looking for (i.e. Egyptian, Civil War, etc.), and a file type such as those listed above.



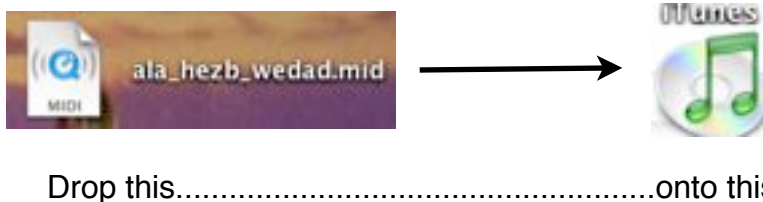
Step 2: When you find a site with music to download, find the file you want. While holding down the option key, click on the link for that file. The file will download to your computer. If there are more files you want repeat the process for each file.

Step 3: Once the music is downloaded there are several ways to get it into iTunes. The easiest is simply to drag file to the iTunes icon. The file should open up in iTunes and begin playing.



# Music from the Internet to CD



Next you need to create a playlist for the music. To do this click on the + button on the bottom left corner of the iTunes window. This will create an untitled playlist in the source window. Change the name of the playlist to something that fits the music you are going to put in that playlist.

Once you have named the playlist you can put music into by dragging the song from the library to the playlist you just created.

Step 3: To burn a CD of the playlist you have just created simply click on the burn icon in the upper right corner of the iTunes window.

iTunes will prompt you to insert a CD. Follow the rest of the directions in iTunes and your CD will finish in a few minutes.
